- Contact with members who are experienced in all aspects of four wheel driving.

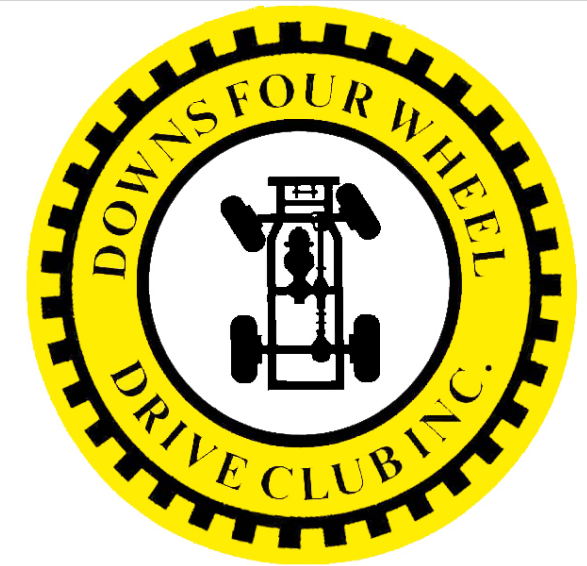


Driver Training

Driver awareness training is an integral part of the Club and is offered to all members. The program is conducted over two sessions - the first being a theory unit which covers the handling of 4WD vehicles in a variety of terrains and the process of travelling in safety under varying conditions. The second session is a practical day of actually driving your own vehicle off-road, including recovery situations.

The training is competency based and certification is available.

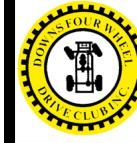
Trips & Activities
